History Give reasons why the Anglo-Saxons raided Britain. Research Viking runes and write a secret message to somebody. This year is the 75 th anniversary of VE Day. Research what life was like on the Homefront during the Second World War. What restrictions did people face and how was their daily life affected? Why was VE Day such a special day? How did people celebrate? Plan your own celebrations.		Geography Draw a map to show the Viking invasion (where the Vikings came from and where they ended up). Explain why you think they left their previous homes and why they chose to come to Britain.	PHSE Make a list of the good things from lockdown. What have you enjoyed? What will you always remember from this time?	D.T./Art Design and create a Viking longboat.
	Music Music Performance - at the end of the year we work towards a class performance. Use whatever you have access to at home to perform. Choose a simple, short melody to learn, it really helps to play along to a song. There are many like this on YouTube. If you do not have a live instrument remember how we have used digital music recently on purple mash. We also use Garageband in school but if you do a search there are other apps available where you can play instruments digitally. Standard Music Notation - Devise a poster showing how to read notes on the staff (treble clef). Draw a staff showing the notes EGBDF and FACE. Draw out a whole musical scale from low (C) to high (A).	Maths Revise 2D and 3D shapes. Include the vocabulary of shape, nets and names of shapes. Revise angles, how to draw, measure and calculate with them. Design a Viking-themed Maths board game and play it with someone at home.	R.E. Sacred Books – the Bible and the Qu’ran. Ask your family if they have any words of wisdom for you. Write these down explaining why they could help you. The Bible and the Qu’ran have words of wisdom that help people. Can you find some examples from both books? Although these sayings/proverbs/words of wisdom may be old do you think they are helpful in today’s world - explain giving reasons.	
English Write your own Horrible Histories sketch, informing your audience about your favourite Viking or Anglo-Saxon facts. Create a fact-file about a famous Anglo-Saxon or Viking.	Science Revise the work on puberty that you did in year 4. Focus on the physical and mental changes that boys and girls go through. Make a booklet or presentation to show your understanding.	P.E.
