<p>Practise counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s at home. See you if you can use objects around the house to help you count (pairs of socks, 2p coins, 5 Rice Krispies). We do this in school, so everyone knows what to do - Can you solve the number sentences independently?</p>	<p>See if you can fill out the Wildlife Trust Nature Table or the 30 Days Wild Bingo (which has been sent home via email). See how many things you can find in your garden or on a local walk.</p>	<p>Ask your grown-up to sign up to Oxford Owl (it's free - link on school website) and read 3 books from the colour band you are on. You could write a review of your favourite book.</p>
<p>Help your grown-up to bake by following a recipe. You can be in charge of measuring out the right ingredients accurately.</p>	<p>Have fun on the Phonics Play website and see if you can sort the words into alien words and real words on the Picnic on Pluto game! www.phonicsplay.co.uk</p>	<p>Do a Joe Wicks workout with someone in your family (available on YouTube and link on school website).</p>
<p>Can you research your favourite piece of fruit? What country was it grown in? Does it grow on a tree? Does your fruit have seeds or pips? Make a poster to display the information you have found out!</p>	<p>Research the four countries of the UK, their capital cities and surrounding seas.</p>	<p>Create your own Joe Wicks style workout and write instructions on how to complete in successfully.</p>
