


# Notes for Parents and Carers




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# What do you notice?



Talk to your grown-up:  
What do you notice?  
How many do they make  
altogether?



There were 5 altogether!

So we know 3 and 2 makes 5

Or

$$3+2=5$$

How many cubes do I need in my second hoop to make 10 altogether?




Can you record your answer on a piece of paper? You could draw the cubes or write the number.

I needed 4 more cubes to make 10!

So 6 and 4 makes 10



Or

$$6+4=10$$

How many cubes do I need in my second hoop to make 10 altogether?





I needed 7 more cubes to make 10!

So 3 and 7 make 10

Or

$$3+7=10$$



How many cubes do I need in my second hoop to make 10 altogether?



1 and 9 make 10!

$$1+9=10$$

$$8+2=10!$$

# Activity 2


First play 'Bond Bubbles' on Purple Mash.

Have fun making number bonds to 5 and 10.



Next, play the number bond game:

- ✓ Find an object you can play Catch with safely.
- ✓ Ask your grown-up to say a number from 0 - 10 and throw the object to you.
- ✓ Then call out the number that makes that number bond to 10.
- ✓ For example, if your adult throws you a 4, you catch and throw back calling out 6!



For this next activity you will need:

✓ To write the numbers 0-10, writing each number on a separate piece of paper.

- Spread your numbers out as best you can.
- Ask your adult to call out a number from 0-10.
- Can you jump on the number that makes the number bond to 10?  
How quick can you be?
- Keep practising!
- Maybe you can call out the numbers and see if your grown-up can find the number that makes that number bond.



- ✓ Now ask your grown-up to hide the numbers.

Ask your adult to call out a number from 0-10.

Can you find the number that makes the number bond to 10?





Can you record the missing dots on these dominos? They are supposed to make 10!




You could draw the domino on a piece of paper or write the number sentence.




